# WHAT WE BELIEVE

We believe the Christian life is not about outward performance or simply following religious rules. At the same time, genuine faith in Christ should lead to growing obedience, spiritual maturity, love for others, and a sincere desire to follow the Lord.

We believe the Holy Spirit is still actively working in the lives of believers today — convicting, leading, strengthening, and transforming people as they walk with the Lord. We desire to remain open to the work of the Holy Spirit while also remaining grounded in the truth and authority of Scripture.

We also believe the church is not merely a collection of disconnected individuals, but a family of believers called together by God to worship Him, grow in His Word, care for one another, and be a light to the world around us.
