Calvary Chapel churches are generally independent churches connected more by shared ministry philosophy and doctrine than by heavy denominational structure or centralized control. We are not opposed to denominations themselves, but we do recognize that unnecessary labels and division can sometimes distract from the unity believers share in Jesus Christ. Another phrase often associated with Calvary Chapel is:

“WHERE GOD GUIDES, GOD PROVIDES.”

This reflects the belief that God is faithful to provide for the work He calls His people to accomplish as they seek to follow Him faithfully.

Calvary Chapel churches have historically emphasized evangelism, discipleship, and living with expectation as believers await the return of Jesus Christ. We believe the next major event on the prophetic calendar is the rapture of the church, and that conviction should move believers to live faithfully, share the gospel, and remain focused on eternal things.

At Calvary Chapel Solid Rock, our desire is not simply to build religious activity, but to help people know Jesus Christ, grow in His Word, walk in His grace, and become lights to the world around them.

WHAT IS CALVARY CHAPEL?

Calvary Chapel is a fellowship of churches that emphasizes teaching the Word of God simply, clearly, and faithfully while encouraging people to grow in a real relationship with Jesus Christ.

While individual Calvary Chapels may differ in certain ways, many share a common philosophy of ministry centered around God's Word, the work of the Holy Spirit, grace, worship, discipleship, evangelism, and real life transformation through following Jesus.

One of the simple phrases often associated with Calvary Chapel is:

**“The Word of God does the work of God
in the people of God.”**

For that reason, Calvary Chapels are especially known for teaching the Bible verse-by-verse in context so people can grow in their understanding of Scripture and learn how to apply God's truth to everyday life.

Rather than focusing primarily on religious systems, traditions, or outward performance, Calvary Chapel has historically emphasized sincere spiritual growth and real life transformation through a relationship with Jesus Christ and consistent exposure to God's Word.

The modern Calvary Chapel movement became widely known during the Jesus Movement of the late 1960s and early 1970s through the ministry of Chuck Smith in Costa Mesa. During a time of cultural confusion and spiritual searching, many young people began coming to Christ as churches opened their doors to people who were searching for truth and hungry to know God.

Rather than focusing heavily on outward appearance, religious background, or social status, the emphasis was placed on teaching the Bible, worshipping sincerely, growing spiritually, and helping people follow Jesus faithfully.

That same philosophy continues to shape many Calvary Chapels today.

At Calvary Chapel Solid Rock, we believe Christianity is not merely about religion, information, or maintaining outward appearances.

It is about knowing the Lord personally and allowing Him to transform our lives through the work of the Holy Spirit and the truth of God's Word.

As people grow in their relationship with the Lord, their lives should gradually begin changing as well. The Christian life is not about trying to earn God's love, but responding to His grace. At the same time, grace should never become an excuse for careless or sinful living. True grace does not produce spiritual apathy or license, but gratitude, humility, repentance, worship, obedience, and a sincere desire to follow the Lord.

Calvary Chapel churches also seek to remain balanced biblically. We desire to avoid unnecessary extremes, legalism, emotionalism, and arguments over secondary issues that distract people from Jesus Christ and the clear teaching of Scripture.

We believe the Holy Spirit is still actively working in the lives of believers today — convicting, leading, strengthening, and changing people as they walk with the Lord. At the same time, we believe spiritual experiences and practices should remain grounded in and consistent with the truth of God's Word.

Calvary Chapels also tend to emphasize servant leadership, simplicity, and ministry that remains centered on people.
